

Medical Screener

Reports to: Medical Screener Supervisor

Mission: Screen Registration Forms and determine type of vaccine client should receive

Qualifications: Medically licensed; nursing preferred

Expectations: Pre-training on role or learn role by observing the current Medical Screeners as they work

What you will need: An identification badge (CPH, FCBH, Agency, or MRC); Algorithm for determining type of vaccine; Walkie-Talkie, Lanyard

Initial Activation:

- Attend education sessions regarding safe work habits and POD organization
- Receive your assignment, your supervisor's name and where he/she will be waiting for you in the POD
- Report to Medical Screener Supervisor
- Review your specific role

Tasks:

- Scan the medical part of every registration form
- Using the algorithm, determine whether client should get Flu Mist, Thimerisol free injection, or multi-dose vial injection
- Using the algorithm, defer any clients who have medical issues that might make the vaccine a risk
- Keep the Registration Form for any client deferred from receiving the vaccine and give to Medical Screener Supervisor
- Mark the form for which type of vaccine the client should receive

End Of Shift:

- Turn in any paperwork or supplies
- Assist in the teardown and re-packing of the assigned area
- Report issues to Medical Screener Supervisor
- Participate in de-briefing, if asked

Identification:

- Wear Identification badge at all times
